Going Green

Amidst growing environmental concerns, CPBI Manitoba has made the move toward sustainability by reducing our use of paper. Paper handouts will not be provided at CPBI breakfast sessions. In the face of large deficit burdens, volatile investment markets and generally a maturing membership, the ability for an employer to sustain its traditional defined benefit pension plan is becoming harder and harder each year. The default alternative to date has been to transition to a defined contribution design; however, changes to legislation in certain jurisdictions and the demand for retirement programs that provide certainty for retirees while being sustainable longer term has sparked interest in alternative solutions.
