- The CPBI is registered federally as one single entity with Industry Canada and operates under the Canadian Not-For-Profit Act. The CPBI is governed by the federal law and its by-laws.
- The CPBI is an open forum to share and discuss ideas; a national gathering point for the presentation of all views through open membership. The CPBI is a non-lobbying organization.
- CPBI offers individual memberships in 4 classes: Regular, Plan sponsor, Associate and Student. Plan sponsor employers can enroll their employees under a group membership.


