



Michael T. Boychuk, FCPA, FCA

Mr. Boychuk is currently the President of Bimcor Inc; one of Canada's largest private sector pension plan managers. Prior to his current position he was the Senior Vice President and Corporate Treasurer of BCE Inc. and Bell Canada (November 1999-2009). Throughout that period Mr. Boychuk was responsible for all Treasury, and Capital Markets activities of the BCE group of companies and until 2005, he was also responsible for all mergers and acquisition activities of the Corporation. He joined BCE in 1997 as President and Chief Executive Officer of BCE Capital, the venture capital arm of BCE Inc. Mr. Boychuk, a Chartered Accountant by profession, began his career with KPMG (Peat Marwick) and later joined the Montreal Trust Company where he held progressively senior positions until 1993. From 1994 to 1997, he co-founded Manitex Capital Inc., a private equity merchant bank.

Mr. Boychuk has been a member of a number of public as well as private sector Boards including MTS, Bell Nordiq, Yellow Media, Optasite and IIROC. He has served on various committees such as Finance, Corporate Governance and has extensive experience working on audit committees including serving as Chair. He currently is a member of the Board of Directors of the Laurentian Bank of Canada and serves on the Audit Committee. He is also a member of the Investment Advisory Committee of Nunavut Trust and the McConnell Foundation. Mr. Boychuk is a Governor of McGill University and is Chair of the University's Audit Committee. He is also a member of the International Advisory Board of the Faculty of Management of McGill University.

Mr. Boychuk is a graduate of McGill University, (BCom 1977, GDPA 1978, CPA, CA 1979, FCPA, FCA 2012). He was appointed a fellow of the institute of Chartered Accountants (Quebec) in 2012 and received the Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee medal for outstanding public and community service in 2013.
