John A. Turner is Director of the Pension Policy Center in Washington, DC, where he provides consulting and research on pension policy. Previously, he worked in the AARP Public Policy Institute and the International Labor Office in Geneva, Switzerland. He has also worked in research offices at the U.S. Social Security Administration and the U.S. Labor Department, where he was the Deputy Director of the pension research office for nine years. He has taught as an adjunct lecturer at George Washington University. He has published 12 books--two have been translated into Japanese and two are required reading for Society of Actuaries examinations. He has published more than 100 articles. He has advised on pension policy in Tajikistan, Tanzania, Albania, Macedonia, Indonesia, Burundi and other countries. He has a PhD in Economics from the University of Chicago.
